Neighborhood Watch has become one of the most effective means of fighting crime in communities since it was organized by The National Sheriff's Association in 1972. It was designed to enlist the participation of citizens to help reduce crime, solve problems, and improve the quality of life in your area. The success of the program has established Neighborhood Watch as the nation's premier crime prevention and community mobilization program. Visible signs of the program are seen throughout America on street signs, window decals, community block parties and service projects.

The MacDonald Highlands Neighborhood Watch Group, with your help, has become the leading source of information about crime and activity in our community. Community residents are more likely to see suspicious activity, a situation or crime and report it, and are in the best position to (1) report code violations and unsafe street conditions, etc. that degrade the quality of life in the community and (2) provide a safe environment in the neighborhood.

The MDHWatch Group is and will remain a separate entity from the HOA and has garnered their support and enthusiasm in the past years before testing NextDoor. Our goal is to create a closed and confidential group again, enlisting the participation of all residents in a communitywide effort to reduce crime in MacDonald Highlands. By working together, we can help fight crime in the most effective way – before it begins.

The HOA will (1) support and provide a meeting place for Neighborhood Watch meetings, (2) hear any recommendations to better the safety of the community, and (3) improve community relations with Allied Security by monitoring their procedures and policies.

The Neighborhood Watch Group will (1) continue to inform residents about suspicious activity and crime in the neighborhood and (2) keep residents abreast of any safety measures that may help to deter crime and (3) make resources available to reduce crime and solve problems.

The residents will (1) report any suspicious activity, code violations, unsafe conditions, concerns or recommendations to Henderson PD and MDHWatch, and (2) stay informed. The suspicious person you see may be the same suspicious person another resident sees, and an incident may be averted. Documentation is also the key resource to support change of policy and procedures. Important: if it is not documented, it did not happen.

A program for residents, by residents. As always, if you have a new neighbor, invite them to join.

LUXURY REAL ESTATE MARKET REPORT MAY 2023

There were 141 sales of \$1 million and higher in May and another 173 pending, a sign the luxury market is picking up after a lull in the second half of 2022 and beginning of 2023. The luxury home market went from eight months of inventory to 6.2 months and the days on the market went from 67 to 56.

The 141 luxury sales in May 2023 is the most since last June 2021 when there were 156. There were 178 sales in May 2022 so the luxury market hasn't fully recovered to its place a year ago. There were 154 sales in May 2021 and 74 in May 2019 prior to the pandemic.

Lisbon

Every year I look forward to our family trip. The number of people always varies depending on school and work, but what stays the same is the incredible memories we make. The idea of coordinating 9 schedules from different cities may seem daunting to some. I've coordinated individual, family and corporate trips of 1-50+ people, so I was ready for the challenge.

This year we took a magical trip to Portugal. With our different schedules, I arranged our diverse flight itineraries. Six of us arrived 3 days early to explore the city of Lisbon. Our private airport/hotel transfer made traveling with an electric scooter and lots of luggage much easier. The private tours to the beach resort town of Cascais and the historic village of Sintra were highlighted by the Romanticist castle Pena Palace. We experienced the beauty of the historic Bairro Alto neighborhood, visited several wine cellars, and took the ferry to the town of Cacilhas for an incredible seafood dinner. We explored the neighborhoods of Alfama and Mouraria and sampled local cheeses, cured meats, codfish cakes, the famous "Pastel de Nata", and Port wine. Our final night in Lisbon was at a spectacular Fado Show followed by a scrumptious dinner at the BAHR restaurant in the Bairro Alto Hotel, voted the 4th best terrace view in the world. The Virtuoso amenities through A Destination Travel included free daily breakfast and \$100 food and beverage credit.

There are a few options to travel from Lisbon to Porto – flight, train or drive. We opted for a private transfer with some stops along the way to experience more of this beautiful country. Our first stop was in the small fishing village of Nazaré, which has one of the most popular big wave surf breaks on the planet. During the winter, colossal waves averaging 50 feet high are created because of the Nazaré Canyon, an underwater geomorphological phenomenon that allows the swell to form to perfect giant waves. During our visit, we were fortunate to catch EHF Beach Handball EURO 2023 in full swing. The next stop was the Shrine of Fatima, which draws pilgrims from all over the world. On festival days, up to 100,000 pilgrims come

to Fátima. Some shuffle on their knees, traversing the mega-huge, park-lined esplanade. In 2017 on the 100th anniversary of the miracle, half a million pilgrims gathered here, including Pope Francis.

In Porto we stayed an additional night before and after our river cruise, giving everyone a buffer for any travel delays. Maison Albar Hotels Le Monumental Palace has amazing views of the famous Aliados Boulevard, along with Michelin-starred Restaurant Le Monument featuring Portuguese cuisine and the delicious Kakuza by Oliver Japanese restaurant. Shopping was a must as we discovered traditional markets, modern malls, tile shops and delicious Vino Verde wine in several areas including Rua de Santa Catarina and Mercado do Bolhão.

The rest of our group joined us in Porto to board our Uniworld River Cruise of the Douro River. Each of Uniworld's ships is decorated to reflect the rivers they sail. S.S. Sao Gabriel is a beautiful representation of Portugal, with its Portuguese tiles and furnishings. All of the staff were welcoming and went out of their way to take care of each guest, including remembering our food and drink preferences every day. For even more pampering, the suites include a butler. Most of the excursions are included, so we were able to experience the Douro Valley and beyond, including the marvel of 5 canal locks, the highest of which is 115 feet.



Some of the excursion highlights in Porto were the UNESCO-designated, 19th-century Stock Exchange Palace and walking through its famous Moorish Revival-style Arab Room; crossing Porto's eye-catching bridges; the 12th century Romanesque Cathedral "Sé"; Sao Bento Station's famous azulejos murals; and the bustling Santa Catarina shopping street full of beautiful cafes, shops and historical landmarks.

We sailed from Porto to Régua where we had our choice of the Douro Museum to learn about winemaking and how the Roman's planted vines in this region over 2,000 years ago, or Lamago which is known for a beautiful sanctuary dedicated to our Lady of Remédios. The evening offered a tour of a breathtaking guinta (estate) and traditional Portuguese dinner. Pocinho gave us two options. The Castelo Rodrigo castle ruins from 1209 and the surrounding village have amazing views and delicious local treats, such as honey, almonds, olive oil and cheeses. The Archaeological Park Of The Côa Valley was discovered in 1990 and has an astonishing collection of prehistoric carvings, among them horses, deer and aurochs that span eons, some as old at 22,000 BC. Docking in Vega De Terrón, we traveled to Salamanca, Spain to visit the 12th and 16th century cathedrals and one of the world's oldest universities, Universidad de Salamanca founded in 1218.

This was the farthest east we could sail, so we headed west to go through the 5 locks again and visit more of this historic country. Back in Régua we learned more about the fascinating process of producing Port wine at the prestigious Sandeman wine estate. Returning to Porto for our last night on the ship, we took a tour to Guimarães, home to the first king of Portugal and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The grand castle appears on Portugal's coat of arms. In addition to the historic beauty of the castle, the main square of Largo da Oliveira, the splendid Monastery and Church of Our Lady of Oliveira and the 14th-century Gothic Padrão do Salado, Guimarães has the youngest population of any city in Europe, so the pedestrian area is full of lively and fun cafés and shops.

We were sad to say goodbye to the amazing staff at Uniworld. We learned a lot from the daily port talks; savored freshly prepared local meals in the Feitoria Restaurant; celebrated local culture with the onboard Fado and Flamenco shows; got our groove on at the 70s dance party; experienced wine sabering, vintage

port bottle opening, and a "Pastel de Nata" cooking demonstration. The beautiful scenery along the Douro River was complimented by card games, tea time and nightly music with DJ Rafael in the Vintage Bar; relaxing with a book on the outdoor couches or in the pool at the Blue Azzelij Terrace; sipping a variety of coffee, tea and hot chocolate from the 24-hour Coffee Station; and unwinding with a spa treatment or workout in the fitness center. I wasn't ready to leave the ship yet, but we had to do some last-minute shopping in Porto before returning home the next morning. Let's be honest, I really wanted some of the rose-shaped ice cream from Porto's main shopping street, Rua de Santa Catarina.

After an amazing Japanese dinner at Kakuza in the Maison Albar Hotels Le Monumental Palace, the 9 of us said good night and goodbye as we had different flights in the morning. Two weeks after our incredible family trip, and I still miss seeing everyone daily. There were enough activities on the ship and onshore to have a comfortable amount of time together. Along with nightly dinners and

some excursions with the whole family, I was able to spend individual time with my husband, kids, parents, sister, aunt and uncle. I highly recommend Portugal to anyone interested in history, food, wine, beaches, surfing and golf.
